


YOUR **CUSTOM DECK**

PACKAGE INCLUDES:

- Decking Material Choices: Brown treated lumber, composite, PVC, or vinyl rolled decking.
- Fasteners: Corrosion-resistant fasteners, connectors, and brackets specific to the type of decking material.
- Post Cement 25kg/bag as required.
- Ledger strip and framing header.
- Stair stringers and steps as needed.
- Choice of: Optional concrete slabs, blocks, or screw piles for foundation.
- Optional: "Joist Guard" 4" or 9" wrap for wood joists.
- Optional: Aluminum railing as required with metal spindles or tempered glass.



BUILDING IN EDMONTON

IN THE CITY OF EDMONTON, PERMITS ARE *GENERALLY **NOT REQUIRED WHEN A DECK IS:**

- Less than 0.6 metres (24 inches) above ground at every point
- Does not have a roof or walls
- Entirely located within a back or side yard
- Not located on a exposed corner lot

*Please check the city of Edmonton website for current permit requirements

CHECK THE FOLLOWING LOCATION RESTRICTIONS TO CREATE A CORRECT SITE PLAN:

- IDENTIFY buried utility lines (DIAL-Before-You-Dig)
- **DO NOT** obstruct gas meters, bedroom windows, HVAC, vents for dryer, furnace, heat recovery ventilation (HRV), etc. Contact ATCO at (780) 424-5222 with questions about gas services and meters.
- IDENTIFY restrictive convenants utility right-of-ways or easements. Check your construction plot plan, real property report, mortgage papers, talk to your home builder, or request a search of records with the city.
- **IDENTIFY** overhead utility lines. Maintain minimum 3.5m (11.5 feet) clearance to electrical wires located above the deck walking surface. Contact EPCOR at (780) 310-4300 with questions concerning clearance from power lines and power pedestals.

If your home is on a corner lot and if your deck includes a roof and / or walls, goes beyond the minimum property requirements and is more than 0.6 metres (24 inches) at every point off the ground, then you will require a permit from the city of Edmonton. (www.edmonton.ca/residential-neighbourhoods)
